This application and all required information are to be personally completed/procured by you. All materials must be submitted to the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Massachusetts and Rhode Island, Attn: Carrie Seitz Educational Grant, 186 Tremont Street, Suite 405, Boston, MA 02111-1096 and postmarked no later than May 31, 2026. Applications must be accompanied by all requested letters and documentation.

ALL of the following must accompany your application:

- **Personal statement** of up to 400 words (no more than 1 1/2 typed pages) of your academic goals and how the Grant will help you accomplish them. Also describe your activities overall, including clubs, teams, work, leadership roles in organizations, academic achievements, internships, etc.
- Copy of most recent academic transcript.
- Letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, or College Counselor. (If entering Freshman year, may be a High School Teacher, High School Advisor or Guidance Counselor.)

**Note that if this grant is awarded, it is a one-time grant only. Grants are usually awarded in late August.**
